



Live-in language assistant



In Spain



Hola People is an agency which offers language courses and different kinds of work programmes to European students. As we are sending and receiving au pairs for many years we have obtained the IAPA membership - International Au Pair Association -, which confirms our professionalism and guarantees a careful selection of families and candidates. As a live-in language assistant you are allowed to gain an insight of a local family in exchange of helping them for a few hours with their children, and teaching them English. Household chores are not required for this position. If you are willing to learn Spanish, you will see that learning another language was never easier and beside of all the cultural aspects, you will get unforgettable experiences.

REQUIREMENTS

- All candidates must be of legal age.
- English speaking native. Basic Spanish minimum.
- In case you are not an EU citizen, you will need at least a tourist visa, and health insurance.
- Some experience in working with children, but more important is that you have maturity, good education, politeness and that you love spending time with children.
- You must be available for at least 2 months.
- It is an advantage to own a driving license.
- No smoking in the home.
- Good health.

CONDITIONS

In general you have to work 5-6 hours per day. There are 2 free days per week (usually the weekend). The needs of our families are as diverse as the ones of our candidates. You have usually to babysit 1-2 evenings per week. One of your benefits of Hola People is, that we match candidates' profiles with families' profiles manually in deep, so that both get along well with each other. You will get a pocket money of around €80 per week for your help.

PROCESS OF PLACEMENT

When you are eligible for interview with one of our families, we will arrange a date and time for you to Skype each other. After that, you are free to say yes or not. If yes, we will help you preparing your trip to Spain. If not, a new family will be introduced to you asap. Please, allow 1 - 2 months for a successful placement.

You need to own an European health insurance card or private medical insurance in case of unexpected incidents during your stay. We recommend you to take out liability insurance too.

The family will help you to have an active social life during your free time. You can attend language lessons a few times per week. The experience as a language assistant requires responsibility and frankness to learn and adapt to the way of life of the family without insisting on your common habits. It is not intended to be a tourist trip nor a school exchange. Your job as a language assistant will be incompatible with other paid jobs at the same time. Hola People will assist you during your whole stay in Spain and will find you a new family if you have proved to be a capable language assistant but no compatibility with the family.

DOCUMENTATION

- A letter of application in English of 1 page & 1/2
- A composition of some pictures of yourself, your family, friends, and works related to children
- 1 or 2 recommendation letters related to work with children in English or Spanish
- Curriculum Vitae in English with photo
- A copy of your ID card/passport and your driving license if you have it

When we receive ALL of the listed documents from you, we will have a short interview by Skype. We believe that it is very important for a successful outcome that we completely know you as well as the family you will be sent to.
